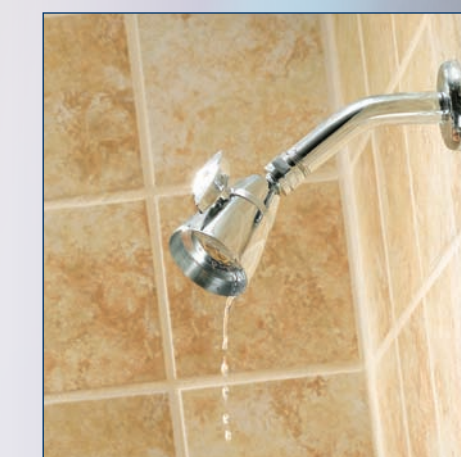
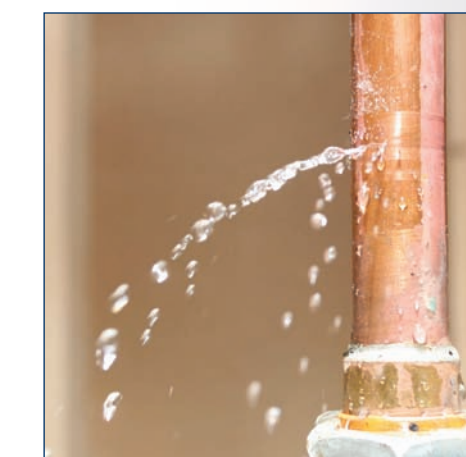
### Leaks. Low water pressure. Discoloration.

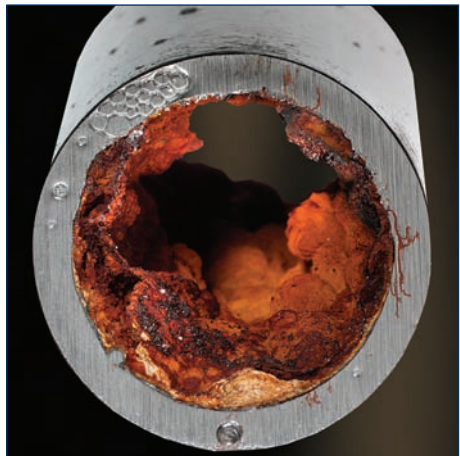
Every year, water problems like these cost building owners and residents \$967 million in repairs, property replacement, insurance claims, and manpower.

### Pipe Replacement: Avoid a constant drain on your budget.

Pipe problems—particularly leaks—are usually addressed with a series of spot repairs. The damaged area gets fixed, but the rest of the plumbing system is ignored. In situations where there is catastrophic pipe failure or where the plumbing system needs design updates, repiping is the preferred alternative.

When this is the case, our experienced team will come in and replace all the pipes in your building. The process requires us to cut into walls and floors to remove and replace the pipes. 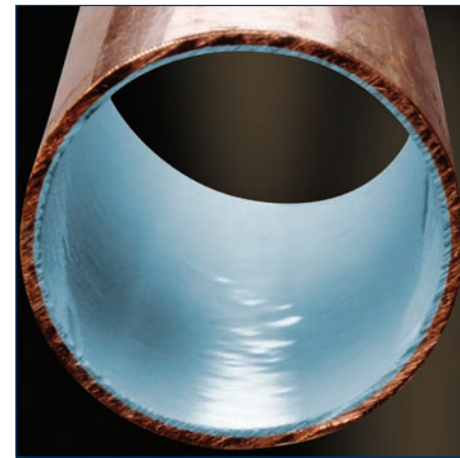
**Crisis: Corrosion.** The cause of most pipe problems is corrosion—a chemical reaction that occurs when water comes in contact with the pipe. The most common effects of corrosion are pinhole leaks—those tiny holes that put a huge burden on your staff and your bottom line. Corrosion can also be responsible for discolored and foul smelling water, and when it builds up within galvanized pipes, it can inhibit flow.

To deal with the corrosion, we offer several effective solutions. Your building might require a pipe replacement. It might call for a pipe restoration solution, like epoxy lining. Or it might need a combination of the two. Let's explore the benefits of each.

### CuraFlo Epoxy Lining: Avoid extensive demolition and disruption.

With our epoxy lining process, we restore your pipes from the inside by lining them with an odorless, tasteless and completely safe epoxy. By fully coating the interior surface, we create a seamless, permanent, protective barrier. With this process, we minimize destruction of walls, ceilings and landscaping. So there's not a lot of mess and residents are not displaced during the process.

**Avoid future corrosion.** While repiping is a long-term solution, it's not a permanent one. Because the environment for corrosion—in which water comes into contact with the metal pipe—still exists. With CuraFlo epoxy lining, water and metal will never touch again. As a result, the chemical processes that create leaks, low flow and contamination won't occur. In fact, with epoxy lining, CuraFlo can extend the useful life of your pipes by 40 to 60 years.
